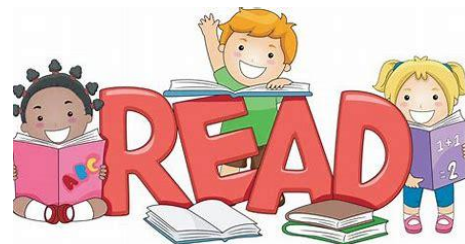

READING



We always try to encourage and support children to find the joy in reading for pleasure and promote reading throughout the school.

We would love you to support your child's reading by regularly reading with them at home. This does not have to be a school reading book; it can be anything that your child is interested in. It has been found that children who read regularly at home are making the most progress. Any discussion and questions about books can help children develop their understanding and comprehension skills so please spend a few minutes chatting to your child about what they have just read and asking questions. We ask that you record a comment in your child's reading diary every time they read with an adult, this doesn't have to be much, just a record of what pages they read and who they read with. **Please ensure children have their reading books and reading diary in school everyday.**

Some Year 2 children will continue to follow the RWI programme so they will bring home a RWI book, which links to what the children are learning in their reading lessons. This book is for the children to read to you. The member of staff who teaches them for RWI will change these books. **Books must be returned before children can take a new book home.**

We have lots of exciting topics planned including looking at the Suffragettes in History, plants in Science and oceans and continents in Geography.

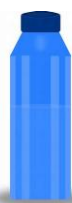
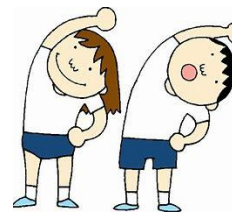


Over the next few weeks, children will be coming home with a log-in for Numbots and Spelling Shed - these are great apps that we use in school and ask the children to use at home to help with arithmetic and spellings.

Eventually we will be sending spellings home each week for children to practice and we will have a test each Friday, this is not a formal test, just an opportunity for children to develop their understanding and confidence of the Year 2 spelling words.

PE

PE will be on a **Monday (outdoor PE) and Friday (indoor PE).** **Please can children come to school dressed in their FULL PE kit** consisting of blue or black shorts (not denim shorts) or blue or black jogging bottoms, a plain white t-shirt and plimsolls or trainers. No named logo or item please if possible. Children will need to wear their school jumper over the top. Children are not allowed to wear any jewellery for PE and long hair must be tied back.
