Year 6 visit to the Black Country Living Museum – 18th March 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Victorians topic, we have arranged for the children to visit the Black Country Living Museum in the West Midlands on Wednesday the 18th of March. The museum is a village made up of genuine Victorian buildings: houses, school, shops, fairground, etc. The children will be learning what it was like to live during the Victorian era, go into a Victorian themed mine and take part in a Victorian school lesson.

Children need to arrive at school at 7:45am. We would expect to arrive back at Jacksdale at around 5.45pm.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch and drink. For any child in receipt of free school meals, please let us know a week before the trip and we can arrange for a packed lunch to be made in school. There is a gift shop at the museum and shops that sell traditional Victorian sweets; children are welcome to bring spending money of up to £15. There is also a Victorian fair ground; the children last year enjoyed going on the rides but they do need to pay for them. As most of the museum is outside, children must bring a coat.

In order for this visit to take place, we need to ask for a payment of £28 per child. This payment can be made using the online School Money system. Payments must be made by Monday the 2nd of March.

Payment will be considered as consent for your child to take part in this visit.
