Admission Arrangements for Pupils with Special Educational Needs and/or Disabilities (SEND) at Jacksdale Primary School

Standard admission arrangements will be followed for pupils with Special Educational Needs and/or Disabilities. At Jacksdale Primary School we pride ourselves on being fully inclusive. All pupils are welcome here.

All our children are supported according to their needs in line with our policy covering 'Equality & Equal Opportunities'. In accordance with this policy, no pupil will be denied admission because of gender, religion, minority status, heritage, physical ability, skill level, SEND need or academic achievement.

We always take all steps possible to provide effective educational provision for all our children. Where a pupil has a particular SEND need, the Governors, senior leadership team and teaching team will ensure that reasonable adjustments are made for that pupil's needs to be fully met, alongside the SENCo. We follow wider school policies to ensure that support is given to all children with additional needs. We always focus on getting the best results or outcomes for all our children, including those with SEND needs.

If a pupil is transferring into the school has an Educational, Health & Care Plan (EHCP) or has been in receipt of extra support from Local Authority centrally funded resources in their previous setting, continuation of this support will be negotiated with the appropriate member of the LA team, to ensure that needs can be met.

If a pupil transferring into the school has been considered as working at the level of SEN Support/K at a previous setting, the SENCo and school staff will liaise with that setting to ensure that appropriate records are transferred and needs are identified, met and understood. AFN or ASN funding may be used to support pupils where Local Authority funding criteria is met.

At Jacksdale Primary School we pride ourselves on working closely with parents. We believe a team approach supports and enables our pupils to achieve.
